# WELCOME to the KIDS ZONE

Ages 6 weeks to 12 years



*We care about you and your children and want to provide the most healthy, comfortable and safe environment possible. In order to do this, the following rules and regulations have been established for you and your children while they are in our care. We appreciate your cooperation and understanding with respect to these procedures. Please help us maintain the health and safety of all the children while in our facility.*

## Hours Of Operation

Monday and Wednesday 8:30am—1pm <b>AND</b> 4pm—8:30pm	Tuesday & Thursday 8:30am—12pm <b>AND</b> 4pm—8:30pm
Friday: 8:30am— 1pm <b>AND</b> 4pm—7pm	Saturday: 8:30am—12pm

## Fees

\$5 per child per visit (Non-members: \$8 per visit, per child)  
 Unlimited Monthly Fees: \$20 one child; \$25 two children; \$30 three or more.

***FAMILY MEMBERSHIPS INCLUDE REGULAR KID ZONE CHARGES.***

*All other members may pay fees at the Front Desk. Your receipt must be shown to the Kids Zone staff as proof of payment and admittance. Monthly fees must be paid on the first visit of the month. Certain special programs and events may require additional fees.*



## Guidelines and Procedures

- All children must have a completed information sheet on file with the club.  
 Parents must register each time they bring children to the Kids Zone by signing in as follows:  
 Your name & child (s) name  
 Location in the club  
 Correct arrival time

**Children MUST be checked in and out of the Kids Zone by their OWN PARENT.**

**No Exceptions.** Staff may ask for ID and will not release children to others.

- Parents **MUST** remain in the Club at all times while children are in the Kids Zone or any youth programs.  
Exceptions will not be made to this policy. Children under 16 may not be in the club, unsupervised for any reason. Children under 12 years are not permitted in the fitness area.
- There is a **Two (2) Hour Limit** for all Kids Zone Visits.  
 In addition, you must pick up your child by Kids Zone closing time.
- Children who are ill will not be permitted to stay in the Kids Zone or other programs. If the Nursery attendant feels that your child is ill, you will be notified right away and your child will not be permitted to stay. Please do not bring your child if they have had vomiting, diarrhea, or a fever 24 hours prior to visiting us. These illnesses include, but are not limited to:  

Pink Eye	Chicken Pox	Strep Throat	Measles/Mumps
Fever	Bad Cough	Flu/Virus	Pin Worm
Skin Rashes:	Poison Ivy/Sumac,	Impetigo	Head Lice
Constant, Heavy Running Nose			

 If your child contracts a communicable disease or serious illness, please contact the Club so that we can notify members and staff.





5. Food and Drink are not permitted in the KidsZone, other than special events or individual circumstances. Please inform staff of any special food precautions for your child.

6. Children who are constant behavior problems will not be permitted to stay in the Kids Zone or other youth programs. These include, but are not limited to:

Biting	Scratching	Pinching	Destruction of Club Property
Hitting	Bad Language	Harmful/Violent Acts	

The staff will discipline your child when needed by use of the "time out" chair. If your child's behavior is consistently disrupting or upsetting to the other children, you will be asked to make other sitting arrangements.

7. Infants should not be brought to the Kids Zone with soiled diapers. We will not change diapers. If your child's diaper becomes soiled we will come get you to change the diaper. Please bring all necessary supplies for your child (diapers, wipes, bottles, snacks, clean clothes, etc.) Please mark your child's name on any item brought to the club. Children should be dressed appropriately for activities indoors and outside.

8. Toys, games and personal belongings brought to the club by you and your children are **NOT** our responsibility. We understand that your child may want a special blanket or toy with him/her while in the Kids Zone. Hard or sharp objects, or toys that may be swallowed by toddlers will not be permitted.

9. The staff are not permitted to administer any medications to your child. Please do not ask them to do so. **ABSOLUTELY NO Exceptions Will Be Made.**

10. If your child is upset and crying without relief for a period of 15 minutes, the staff has the option to request parental assistance.

11. Children over the age of 3 are not permitted in the locker room of the opposite sex.
